What devices support ARC Adventures?

ARC Adventures work on many devices that run Windows, Android, MacOS, and iOS. See the technical details to see if your device meets the necessary hardware specifications.

My child/student forgot their username/password.

Depending on your districts, students may log into ARC Adventures using custom usernames and passwords, Clever, or Classlink. If you are unsure of your login credentials, please reach out to your teacher or school administrator. Custom usernames and passwords can be modified by your teacher or school administrator. These changes must be made through the Manage ARC Adventures page in SchoolPace.

I installed ARC Adventures, but now I can't play.

It is important to remember that ARC Adventures requires the player be connected to wifi at all times in order to track accurate student data and to give you the best possible experience. If you have any questions about what information is shared, please ask your district.

Is data collected from this game?

ARC Adventures does track student progress in order to provide individualized instruction. If you have any questions about what information is shared, please ask your district.

There is no personal (non-school associated) version of the game at this time. All accounts must be tied to schools with an active subscription.

Only 1G is available at this time, but additional reading levels are in early stages of development.
